THE BARINGO COUNTY FINANCE ACT, 2019

AN ACT of the Baringo County to provide for various taxation, imposition of fees and charges for services, and other revenue raising measures by the County Government, and for matters incidental thereto

ENACTED by the Baringo County Assembly as follows—

Short Title

1 This Act may be cited as the Baringo County Finance Act, 2019 and shall subject to section 2(2) come into operation immediately after ascent by the Governor and published by *Kenya Gazette* or on such a date as the County Executive Committee Member for Finance may appoint and different dates may be appointed for different provisions

Imposition, revision of the taxes, fees, etc of the County

2 The Finance Act 2019, seeks to prescribe the rates of taxes and charges for the assessment year 2019-2020 the rates at which taxes and other charges will be payable during the financial year 2019-2020 from properties businesses markets Agricultural produce outdoor advertisement vehicle parking, heritage sites game reserves and national reserves among others until another bill is passed by the Baringo County Assembly

Directions, resolutions, etc under Local Government

3 All directions resolutions orders and authorizations on financial management including the collection and administration of taxes, fees and charges given or issued by the defunct Councils and subsisting or valid immediately before the Cessation of the application of the Local Government Act (now repealed) shall be deemed to have been given issued or made pursuant to this Act until the expiry amendment or repeal of those directions resolutions orders and authorizations on financial management and shall continue with the necessary modifications apply to the payment and the administration of the taxes fees and other levies under this Act

(i) Implementation of the Finance Act

This Finance Act shall be implemented together with the following laws, the Baringo County Trade Licence Act 2014 The Baringo County Property rates Act 2014 The Baringo County Revenue Administration Act 2014 the Baringo Agricultural Produce Cess Act 2015 and other revenue laws,

- (ii) Trade License Permit to have the same meaning as Single Business Permit

**PARTII—TAXES, FEES AND CHARGES PAYABLE AND RATES
APPLICABLE**

Rate of property-Tax (Subject to Baringo County Property Rates Act, 2014)

4 Rates of property-tax in respect of property liable to tax for the assessment year 2019-20

In respect of properties of all categories of owners liable to tax for the assessment year 2019-20, the rates of property-tax have been specified in Part VII of the first schedule to the Act

These are the same as those laid down in the valuation roll in force at the date of this BILL for the purposes of computation of property tax due

- (i) Penalties on outstanding rates—

Penalties shall be levied in respect of property liable to tax for the assessment in the financial year 2019-20 in the following cases—

In the case of a property having total outstanding rates at the turn of the calendar year the amount of property tax computed shall be increased by a penalty calculated at 3% cumulative per month

- (a) In the case of properties, owned by national government the property tax computed in which case the contribution in lieu of rates outstanding shall be increased by a penalty of 3% for the purpose of such property tax

However marginal relief shall be allowed in cases where the amount is cleared by the turn of the year to ensure that annual amount of the property tax payable does not accrue penalties until after 31st of March in each calendar year

- (b) Further in the case of every property with a registered title deed total property tax under this section (herein referred to as property tax) and where such properties having been registered for more than seven years preceding the year of notification, marginal relief shall be provided to exclude any charges beyond seven years

House rent

5 In the case of housing units the rate of rental charges has been specified in Part 5 8 of the First Schedule to the Act A surcharge shall be levied for rental default at a cumulative rate of 5 % per month

Single business permit (Subject to Baringo County Trade License Act, 2014) Single business permit in respect of businesses liable to tax for assessment year 2019-2020

6 In respect of businesses of all categories of owners liable to tax for assessment year 2019-2020 the rates of single business permits have been specified in Part 4 Schedules to the Act These are the same as those laid down in Column 1 2 and 3 of the Second Schedule for the purpose of assessment of business charges

Penalties on outstanding licenses

Penalties shall be levied in respect of business liable to tax for the assessment year 2019-2020 in the following cases—

- (a) in the event of a business having total outstanding licenses at the turn of the calendar Year the amount of license computed shall be increases by a penalty calculated at 30% of the license amount

However marginal relief shall be allowed in cases where the amount is cleared by the turn of the year to ensure that the annual amount of single business permit payable does not accrue penalties until after 31st March in each calendar year

Stock Cess and Slaughter Fees

7 In respect of specified stock produce for the assessment year **2019-2020** the rates of fees have been specified in 3 5 of the Second schedule to the Act

Agricultural Produce Cess

8 Produce Cess in respect of specified agricultural produce Cess charges for the assessment year **2019-2020**, the rates of Cess charges have been specified in **3 5** of the Second Schedule to the Act These are the same as laid down in the Baringo County agricultural produce Act of **2015**, for the purpose of computation of Cess charges due on Cessable produce

Building Plan Approval

9 In respect of building as defined in Physical Planning Act of 1996, the approval charges for the assessment year 2019-2020 the rates of charges have been specified in Schedule 5 5

Advertisements

10 In respect to advertisements as defined in the Physical Planning Act of 1996 interpretation 2 of 2007, 5th Schedule For the assessment year 2019/2020 the rate of advertisement charges has been specified in Schedule 5 4

Market Fees

11 In respect of designated County markets traders operating within the markets are liable to fees and charges for assessment year 2019-2020, the rates of fees and charges have been specified in schedule 3 5 of the Act

County Reserves Fees

12 In respect to designated County reserves and heritage site visitors touring the parks These sites are liable to fees and charges for assessment in 2019-2020 the rates of fees and charges have been specified in schedule 3 0 of the Act

Tourism sector is a potential segment of the County economy following the devolution of this function the County proposes to levy charges for its parks and heritage sites, for the assessment year **2019/20**, the rate of charges have been specified in the Second Schedule

Health Charges and Fees

13 In respect of designated County dispensaries and health facilities patients visiting the facilities are liable to fees and charges for assessment year 2019-2020 The rates of fees and charges have been specified in Schedule 7 0 of the Act

Parking Fee

14 In respect to designated County central business district for street and bus parks, the owners of vehicle parking in designated areas are liable to fees and charges for assessment year 2019-2020 the rates of fees and charges have been specified in Schedule 6 1 of the Act

Education and Social Facilities Charges

15 In respect of use of County public amenities and registration of educational and social organization for assessment year 2019-2020, the rates of fees and charges have been specified in Schedule 8 1 of the Act

Sale of Documents

16 In respect to County generated documents gazettes and books for assessment year 2019-2020, the rates of fees and charges have been specified in Schedule 2 2 of the Act and a surcharge for bouncing cheque as set out in Schedule 4 2

PART III—WIDENING OF TAX BASE

Horticultural Cess

Horticultural sector is a growing segment of the County economy but the trading of flowers remained largely unregulated resulting in non-collection of levies In order to collect tax at the earliest point of time and also to improve reporting mechanism of billions in the flower farming segment it is proposed that a charge KSh 0 2 per kilogramme shall be paid by the producer/seller

PART IV—MEASURES TO PREVENT NON-REMITTANCE OF COLLECTION REVENUE

In order to enhance the existing measures and to ensure all revenue is remitted it is recommended for—

- (i) maximum use of technology for collection and monitoring cash receipts this include the use internet banking and connection of all work stations to Integrated Financial Management Information system for real time monitoring of cash flow in addition to the automation of cash receipts
- (ii) putting measures in place to prevent loss of revenue including making entry of all accountable documents within the information system
- (iii) to ensure timely approval of building plan and enhanced revenue collection the submission of building plans be automated
- (iv) digitalize all County mutations to allow prompt management of property liable to property tax,
- (v) automation of parking fee collection to enhance revenue collection and administration efficiency

- (vi) regular monitoring of system generated bills to ensure increased processing rate and
- (vii) opening up of Revenue collection points to increase revenue flow

PART V—RATIONALIZATION OF INTER-COUNTY TAXATION PROVISION

In respect to the power to the County to impose taxes and other revenue raising measure it is proposed that the mobility of goods from other Counties be accompanied by movement permits to enhance Article 209(5) of the 2010 Constitution

PART VI—GENERAL ANTI-EVATION RULE

In the background of multiple charges, the rate of evasion is more pronounced hence administrative inefficiency and loss of revenue It's accordingly proposed to provide general anti evasion rule in the Finance Act to deal with loss of revenue

The main features of such a regime are—

- (i) movement of goods across counties will be subject to movement permits agreed among counties
- (ii) automating collection point and processing for real time monitoring,
- (iii) imposition of fine penalties for mitigating tax evasion
- (iv) physical mapping of business premises within the County major Centre s and markets and
- (v) standardization of agricultural produce packaging
