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THE HOMA BAY COUNTY FINANCE BILL, 2016

A Bill for

AN ACT of the Homa Bay County to provide for various taxation, imposition of fees and charges for services, and other revenue raising measures by the county government; and for matters incidental thereto

ENACTED by the County Assembly of Homa Bay, as follows—

PART I—PRELIMINARY PROVISIONS

1. This Act may be cited as the Homa Bay County Finance Act, 2016 and shall, subject to section 2(2), come into operation on such a date as the County Executive Committee Member for Finance may appoint and different dates may be appointed for different provisions.

Short title and commencement.

2. In this Act unless the context otherwise requires—

Interpretation

“Authority” means power given by the people of Homa Bay County through the County Assembly of Homa Bay;

“Authorized channel” means the method, mode or process of collection of County revenue or making payments to the county as approved by the County Government;

“Authorized Officer” means the County Executive Member for the time being in charge of Finance and Economic Planning or any person authorized by him/her in writing to act as such for the purpose of enforcing this Act;

“Business” means

- (a) Trade, commerce or manufacture, profession, vocation or occupation;
- (b) Any other activity in the nature of trade, commerce, or manufacture, profession, vocation or occupation;
- (c) Any other activity carried on by a person continuously or regularly, whether or not for gain or profit and which involves, in part or in whole, the supply of goods or services

“Cess” means tax or fees charged for goods specified in the first schedule;

“County” means the County of Homa Bay;

“County Government” means the County Government of Homa Bay;

“County Public Officer” means a County Public Officer within the meaning of Section 2 of the County Government Act, 2012;

“County Receiver of Revenue” means the County Public Officer appointed pursuant to section 158 of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012 for the purpose of collecting revenue for the County Government and remitting it to the County Receiver of Revenue;

“Enforcement Officer” means an officer of the National Police Service or of the County Government designated as a county enforcement officer;

“Executive Member” means the Executive Committee Member responsible for Finance and Economic Planning;

“Township” means a town as defined under section 10 of the Urban Areas and Cities Act;

PART II—CHARGES, FEES, LICENSES, PERMITS, RENT AND CESS

3. (1) The services listed under the First Schedule shall be charged a fee at the rate specified therein.

Market Fees and Charges.

(2) The transportation of building materials listed under the First Schedule Part 3 & 4 shall only be extracted between 6:00 am and 6:00 p.m daily

(3) The impounding services listed under the Second Schedule shall be charged a fee at the rate specified therein.

(4) The services listed under the Third Schedule shall be charged a fee at the rate specified therein.

4. (1) A person intending to operate a business listed in the Forth Schedule shall apply for a specified license or permit.

Licenses and Permits

(2) A person applying for a business license or permit under this section shall pay the fees stipulated in the Forth

Schedule.

(3) A person who applies for license under subsection (2) shall be issued with a license on the payment of the applicable fee, depending on the location and size of the business as specified in the Forth Schedule.

(4) Licenses and permits issued under subsection (3) must be visibly displayed at the business premise at all times

(5) A person who operates a business without a licence or permit commits an offence and shall be liable to a fine of Kenya shillings—

- (a) ten thousand in the case of an individual; or
- (b) fifty thousand in the case of a registered business; or
- (c) to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three (3) months

5. (1) A person operating a business or trades stipulated under the Sixth to the Eleventh Schedule or providing services requiring a permit stipulated under the Schedules shall apply for a permit and pay the stipulated fees and charges

(2) A person who contravenes this section commits an offence and shall be liable to a fine of Kenya shillings—

- (a) ten thousand in the case of an individual; or
- (b) fifty thousand in the case of a registered business; or
- (c) to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months.

PART III—PAYMENT

6. (1) All payments to the County Governments made under this Act shall be paid through the authorized channel.

Payments to the
County Government.

(2) The County Revenue Collector authorized by the County Government to collect revenue shall have an identification card issued by the County Government which shall be worn visibly by such County Revenue Collector:

(3) An official receipt shall be issued for all payments

made to the County Government.

(4) Every person who makes a payment through an authorized channel shall demand an official receipt for each such payment and every payment made.

(5) A person shall not receive or collect any money on behalf of the County Government unless such a person has been appointed to do so or has authority as the receiver and collector of County Government Revenue.

(6) A person who contravenes the provisions of this section commits an offence and shall be liable to a fine of Kenya Shillings two thousand or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding two months or both.

7. (1) In this section—

Appointment of
agents and their
duties

"agent" means a person appointed as such under subsection (2);

Under this subsection "appointment notice" means a notice issued by the County Executive Committee Member appointing an agent;

(2) The County Executive Committee Member may by written notice addressed to any person—

- (a) appoint any person to be an agent of the County Government for the purposes of the collection or recovery of charges, permit fees, licence fees, rent, cess and such other fees, as may be necessary for carrying out the purposes of this Act; and
- (b) specify the amount of charges, permit fees, licence fees, rent, cess and such other fees to be collected or recovered by the agent.

(3) An agent appointed under this section shall enforce and ensure due compliance with the provisions of this Act and shall remit all revenue collected to the County Government through the County Receiver of Revenue or as may be otherwise instructed in the appointment notice.

(4) Where an agent claims to be, or to have become unable to comply with subsection (3), such shall, within seven working days, notify the County Executive Committee Member in writing, setting out fully the reasons

for his inability to comply, and the County Executive Committee Member shall accept the notification and cancel or amend the appointment notice accordingly.

(5) Unless and until a notification is given by an agent under subsection (4), sufficient moneys for the payment of charges, permit fees, licence fees, rent, cess and such other fees specified in the agent's appointment notice shall be presumed to be held by him and this money shall be due and payable to the County Government.

(6) For the purposes of this section, the County Executive Committee Member may, by notice in writing, at any time, require any person to furnish him or her, within reasonable time not being less than seven days from date of service of the notice, with information showing any monies which may be held with the agent for, or due by the agent to the government.

(7) where an agent fails to pay an amount of money collected under this section within the time specified within the notice, the provisions relating to this Act relating to the collection and recovery of revenue shall apply to the collection and recovery of that amount as if it were revenue due and payable by the agent, the due date for the payment of which that amount should have been paid to the government under this section.

(8) an agent who makes a payment to the government under this section shall for all purposes be deemed to have acted under the authority of the government, and shall be indemnified in respect of that payment against all proceedings and all processes notwithstanding any provisions to the contrary in any written law, contract and agreement.

PART IV—ENFORCEMENT POWERS AND PRIVILEGES

8. The Authorized Officer shall have the power, right or authority to—

Power of seizure,
Bond or Arrest

- (a) Seize any tool or goods of trade or any person found trading or carrying on or entering into or engaging in any trade or occupation or business at any point of time within Homa Bay County without valid county permit for the said trade,

occupation or business.

- (b) Bond or arrest any person found trading or carrying on or entering into or engaging in any trade, occupation or business at any point of time within Homa Bay County without a valid county permit for the said trade, occupation or business.

9. (1) Every business permit issued under finance act shall be shall be displayed or exhibited in prominent and conspicuous place in the premises to which it relates.

Display of Permits
on Premises

(2) Business permits include all annual single business permits, monthly, weekly or daily permits in form of licenses, receipts or exemption permits.

10. Enforcement Officers of the county or any other person duly authorized by the County Government of Homa Bay in writing may at any reasonable time enter any premises whether having business permit under this Act to undertake inspections, make enquiries, or perform any other act attached to the conditions of any business permit issued or transferred under this Act.

11. Any person who hinders, obstructs, interferes with or prevents enforcement officers or any other person duly authorized in writing by the County Government of Homa Bay in exercising his/her powers under Article 4 of this Act – to give false or misleading information to any such officer in the course of such inspection or enquiries or acts relevant to the conditions of the business permit issued or transferred under this Act – shall be guilty of an offence.

Persons Guilty of
Offences

12. (1) In case of first conviction, any person found guilty of an offence under this Act shall be liable to a fine not exceeding Kenya Shillings Ten Thousand Only (KSh. 10,000) or a prison term not exceeding fifteen (15) months or both such fine and imprisonment.

Penalty

(2) In case of second or subsequent conviction for an offence under this Act, the convict shall be liable to a fine not exceeding Kenya Shillings Fifteen Thousand Only (KSh. 15,000) or a prison term not exceeding fifteen (15) months or both such fine and imprisonment.

PART V – MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

13. The County Executive Committee member may

exempt, waive or vary fees or charges payable under this Act accordance to the criteria prescribed in the regulations.

15. A member of staff of the County government or any other person having a duty to perform under this Act who —

Offences involving
staff of the County
Government

- (a) makes , in any record, or document required to be kept or made by that person, an entry which he or she knows or has reasonable cause to believe not to be true or to be false;
- (b) willfully refuses to do anything which he or she knows or has reasonable cause to know is required to be done;
- (c) interferes with any other person or process under this Act, so as to defeat the provisions, requirements or purposes of this Act;
- (d) where required under this Act to do anything to give effect to the provisions of this Act, fails to do such thing;
- (e) without reasonable cause omits to do something in breach of his or her duty under this Act;
- (f) willfully contravenes the provisions of this Act to give undue advantage or favour to another person;
- (g) fails to prevent or report to the County Government or any other relevant authority, the commission of an offence committed under this Act; commits an offence and is liable on conviction, to a fine not exceeding two hundred thousand shillings or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year, or both.

16. (1) The Executive Member may by order published in the gazette amend any of the schedules subject to any written national or county law.

Amendment of
Schedules

(2) Any order made under subsection (1) shall be laid before the County Assembly without unreasonable delay for consideration and approval.

17. (1) Any charges, permit fees, licence fees, rent, cess and such other fees payable to the County Government at the commencement of this Act which are not included in

Savings

any of the Schedules to this Act, shall continue to be chargeable by, and payable to the County Government unless they are repealed by an Act of the County Government or until an Act of the County Government on such charges, permit fees, licence fees, rent, cess and such other fees is enacted.

(2) All directions, resolutions, orders and authorizations on, or relating to financial management, including the collection and administration of fees and charges given or issued by the previous county councils, municipal councils, town councils or urban councils, before the commencement of this Act shall be deemed to have been given, issued or made by or under the authority of the County Assembly until the expiry or repeal of those directions, resolutions, orders and authorizations, and shall continue, with the necessary modifications, to apply, be paid and administered under this Act: provided that this sub-section shall also apply to such fees and charges levied by various ministries and departments of the national government in respect of functions devolved to the county governments under part 2 of the Fourth Schedule of the Constitution of Kenya which fees and charges shall be levied by the County Government on transfer of the devolved functions.

18. Unless otherwise provided in this Act, the rates for Cessation fees, charges, licences, cess or rent, applicable before the commencement of this Act in respect of any business, activity, goods or services listed in the schedules, shall cease to apply.

Cessation.

19. Notwithstanding the provisions of this Act, the fees and charges may be varied upon the enactment of any county law regulating any of the stipulated licences in the schedules or any appropriate approval shall apply.

Variations by other laws.

20. Any person who, before the commencement of this Act was a holder of a valid licence or permit provided under this Act shall continue holding such licence or permit until the stipulated expiry date.

Transition.

21. The County Executive Committee Member may Regulations make regulations for the better carrying out of the purposes and provisions of this Act.
