Kakamega County Finance

THE KAKAMEGA COUNTY FINANCE ACT, 2018

AN ACT of the County Assembly of Kakamega County to enable the County Government to raise revenue through taxes, fees, charges and other receipts on businesses, commercial activities and on use of services and facilities offered by County Government for 2018/19 Fiscal year, and for connected purposes

ENACTED by the County Assembly of Kakamega County as follows—

PART I –PRELIMINARY

1. This act may be cited as the Kakamega County Finance act, 2018 and shall come into operation upon publication.

Short title and commencement

2. In this act unless the context otherwise requires-

Interpretation

“Authorized officer” means an authorized officer under this act;

“County “ means Kakamega County;

“ County Assembly” means County Assembly of Kakamega County;

“County pound” means a holding place for vehicles, animals, goods etc. until they are placed back in the control of the owner;

“County receiver of revenue” means the Kakamega County Revenue Agency established under section 4 of the Kakamega County Revenue Administration and Management Act, 2017;

“Executive Committee Member” means Executive Committee Member responsible for Finance;

“Vehicle” includes cars, lorries, trailers, busses, pick-ups, canters, tuk tuks, tractors and motor cycles.

PART II-TAX , FEES, CHARGES AND OTHER RECEIPTS PAYABLE AND APPLICABLE RATES

3. The County Government shall have the power to impose taxes, fees, charges and other receipts on businesses, commercial activities and on use of services and facilities offered by County Government.

General power to impose charges, fees, taxes, receipts, etc

4. (1) The County Government shall impose fees and other charges on impounded buildings, items, goods or any other property as prescribed in the First Schedule.

Fees and other charges on impounded items, goods etc

(2) Any item, goods or any other property impounded under sub section (1) and taken to the County pound yard shall attract a daily storage charge as prescribed in the First Schedule.

5. (1) The County Government shall charge rates and property rent on ratable public land and property within the County as prescribed in the Second Schedule.

Rates and other charges relating to land

(2) The Executive Committee Member may prescribe interest to be charged on any rates or any part thereof that remains unpaid after the day on which the rates became payable.

6. The County Government shall impose a business trade licence fees to a person who carries out the business of general trader, retail services, shop, professional services, financial services, insurance services or any other related business as prescribed in the Third Schedule on calendar year basis.

Licence fees for general trader, shop, retail services etc

7. The County Government shall charge fees prescribed in the Fourth Schedule for any person seeking any of the following services –

Fees for prescribed services

- (a) solid waste management;
- (b) environmental assessment;
- (c) physical planning services;
- (d) valuation and property management;
- (e) estate development;
- (f) firefighting;
- (g) engineering ;
- (h) quantity survey; and
- (i) library services.

8. The County Government shall charge the fees prescribed in the Fifth Schedule to any person who erects or displays an outdoor advertisement and signage in the County.

Fees for outdoor advertising

9. The County Government shall charge the fees prescribed in the Sixth Schedule to any person who operates a transport business within the County or who parks his or her vehicle in designated parking areas within the County.

10. (1) The County Government shall charge fees prescribed in the Seventh Schedule to any trader selling goods and services at the market place.

Market fees

(2) For purposes of this section, a market place includes a market and its surrounding.

11. The County Government shall charge the fees prescribed in the Eighth Schedule to any person who operates a business of, or deals in betting, casinos and other forms of gambling within the county.

12. (1) A person who seeks to hire or use prescribed County facilities including machines, stadium grounds, halls or other facilities shall first seek and obtain permission from the authorized officer of the relevant county department.

(2) The County Government shall charge fees prescribed in the Ninth Schedule for use of County machines, stadium, grounds, halls or other County facilities.

(3) For purposes of this section an authorized officer of a relevant department means the chief officer of the department or a person authorized in that behalf in writing by the chief officer.

13. A student on attachment or a person who carries out research in county health facilities or a person who utilizes county public health services shall pay fees prescribed in the Tenth Schedule.

14. A person who seeks and receives veterinary and cooperatives services from the County facilities or personnel shall pay fees prescribed in the Eleventh Schedule.

PART III- MISCELLANEOUS

15. The Executive Committee Member may exempt, waive or vary fees or charges payable under this Act as may be

16. (1) Any payment under this Act shall be made to the County Receiver of Revenue through the prescribed bank accounts.

(2) An official receipt shall be issued for all payments made to the County Receiver of Revenue.

(3) A person shall not receive or collect money on behalf of the County Receiver of Revenue unless he or she has been authorized in writing by the County Receiver of Revenue.

17. (1) An authorized officer may, at all reasonable times and upon production of an identification card to any person so requesting -

Power of entry and
inspection

- (a) enter any land or buildings occupied by the holder of a license issued under this Act; and
- (b) make such inspection and enquiries as may be necessary for ascertaining whether the provisions of this Act or the terms and conditions of the respective license are being complied with.

(2) For purposes of this section, authorised officer has the same meaning as authorised officer in section 2 of The Kakamega County Revenue Administration and Management Act, 2018

18. Any charges ,fees or tax payable to the County government at the commencement of this Act but which is not included in any of the schedules to this Act shall continue to apply under the existing laws until such laws are specifically repealed .
