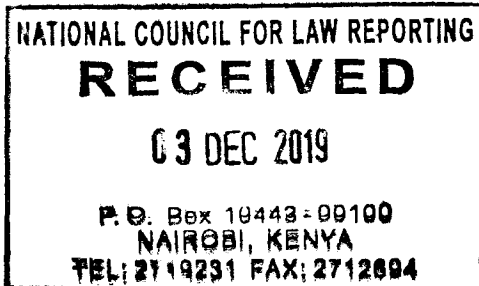

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THE KERICHO COUNTY FINANCE BILL, 2019

A Bill for

AN ACT of the County Assembly of Kericho to provide for the imposition or variation of various Permits, Fees, Cess, Licenses or Charges for services and for connected purposes

ENACTED by the County Assembly of Kericho as follows—

PART I—PRELIMINARY

1. This Act may be cited as the Kericho County Finance Act, 2019 and shall come into operation as follows—

Short title and
Commencement

- (a) Part I, II, III, IV, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX and X of the Schedule on 1st November 2019; and
- (b) Part XI, of the schedule on 1st January, 2020.

2.(1) In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires —

Interpretation.

“agent” means a person appointed as such under section 10(1);

“appointment notice” means a notice issued by the Executive Committee member appointing an agent under Section 10(2);

“business” means—

- (a) trade, commerce or manufacture, profession, vocation or occupation; or
- (b) any other activity in the nature of trade, commerce or manufacture, profession, vocation or occupation; or
- (c) any activity carried on by a person continuously or regularly, whether or not for gain or profit and which involves, in part or in whole, the supply of goods or services for consideration

“Non-Compliance” means failure by business entities, citizens or non-citizens to act in accordance with fees, charges, rules and regulations passed by the County Assembly.

“County” means County Government of Kericho;

“County Assembly” means County Assembly of Kericho;

“Zone A” means Kericho Town;

“Zone B” means Litein Town, Kapkatet Town, Roret Town, Kipkelion Town, Fort Tenan Town, Londiani Town, Chepseon Town, Hill Tea Town, Sisiot, Kabianga Town, Sondu Town, Kipsitet Town, Ainamoi Town, Kapsoit Town and Kapkugerwet Town.

“Zone C” means other markets other than “Zone A and B”;

“County executive committee member” means the county executive member in charge of Finance and Economic Planning.

PART II—REGULATIONS, CHARGES, LICENSES, FEES, RENT AND CESS

3. The Fees provided in this Act shall be charged for the services specified in the relevant section. Charges

4. (1) A person shall not carry out, within the County, any business or service specified in the Schedule without a license issued by the relevant County office. Licenses, Permits

(2) A person intending to carry out any of the businesses specified in the Schedule shall apply for a license from the relevant County offices.

(3) A person applying for license under subsection (2) shall be issued with a license on the payment of a fee, depending on the location and size of the business, as is specified in the relevant section.

(4) A person who contravenes a provision of this section commits an offence.

In the event of a business having total outstanding licenses at the turn of the calendar Year the amount of license computed shall be increased by a penalty calculated at three (3) percent cumulative per month and thirty (30) percent above the normal rate.

However, marginal relief shall be allowed in cases where the amount is cleared by the turn of the year to ensure that annual amount of single business permit

payable does not accrue penalties until after 31st of March in each calendar year.

5. (1) A person carrying on any activity specified in the Act shall pay to the relevant office a fee at the rate set out in the relevant Part. Fees.

(2) A person who carries on an activity listed in the Schedule and fails to pay the fee referred to under subsection (1) commits an offence

6. (1) A person occupying any plot, stall or house leased or rented out by the County shall pay the annual rent, at the rate specified in the Schedule. Plot or House Rent.

(2) The rent referred to under subsection (1) shall be due in case of—

(a) a plot, on the 1st day of January in each year;

(b) a house or stall on the 30th day of each month.

(3) A person who contravenes the provisions of subsection (1) or (2) may be evicted by the County and shall be evicted if he or she fails to pay the rent for three consecutive months.

(4) A penalty of two percent cumulative per month shall be charged for any outstanding amount of rent for a plot that remains unpaid after the 31st day of March.

(5) Further, in the case of a property with a registered title deed/lease certificate the total property tax under this section (herein referred to as property tax) and where such properties having been registered for more than seven years preceding the year of notification, marginal relief shall be provided to exclude any charges beyond seven years.

This takes effect from 1st January, 2020

7. (1) Access or market fee shall be charged on the goods specified in the relevant Part of the Schedule at the rate specified. Cess or Market Fee.

(2) A person who fails to pay the cess or market fee set under subsection (1) commits an offence.

8. (1) Harvesting and transportation of natural Resources from the source shall be done between 6 A.M.

and 6 P.M.

(2) The natural resources referred in 8(1) shall be:

- (a) Quarry Stones
- (b) Sand
- (c) Ballast
- (e) Bricks
- (f) Forest Produce
- (g) All natural resources used in public road or bridge construction
- (e) Any Other Natural Resource mined for commercial purpose

9. (1) The Executive Committee Member responsible for finance may forward to the County Assembly a legislative proposal entailing amendments of the schedules for consideration.

Amendments to the
Schedule.

(2) Any proposed legislation made under subsection (1) shall be laid before the County Assembly without unreasonable delay, and unless a resolution approving the proposed legislation is passed by the County Assembly within twenty-one days when the Assembly next sits after the proposed legislation is so laid, the proposed legislation shall lapse.

PART III—PAYMENT

10. (1) Any payment to the County shall be made to an officer appointed by the County to collect revenue or through any other mode of payment as may be prescribed by the County Executive Committee Member.

Payment to the
County.

(2) An officer appointed by the County to collect revenue shall have identification card issued by the County which shall be pinned or tagged where it can be easily identified by any person.

(3) A County official receipt shall be issued for all payments made to the County.

(4) A person shall not receive or collect any money on behalf of the County unless he or she has been appointed to do so or has authority as the receiver and collector of the County revenue.

(5) Payment of fees and charges levied by the county shall be in cash, mobile payment, EFT, Bank Deposit or any other mode of payment advised by the CEC Finance and Economic Planning.

(6) A person who contravenes the provisions of this section commits an offence.

11. (1) The County Executive Committee Member may by written notice addressed to any person—

Appointment and
Duties of an Agent.

(a) appoint him to be the agent of the county for the purposes of the collection or recovery of charges, licenses, fees, rent or cess, as may be necessary for carrying out the purposes of this Act;

(b) Specify the amount of charges, licenses, fees, rent or cess to be collected or recovered.

(2) An agent appointed under this section shall enforce and ensure due compliance with the provisions of this Act and shall remit all revenue collected to the county as per the appointment notice

(3) Where an agent claims to be, or to have become, unable to comply with subsection (2), he shall, within seven working days, notify the Executive Committee Member in writing setting out fully the reasons for his inability to comply, and the Executive Committee Member shall accept the notification and cancel or amend the appointment notice accordingly.

(4) Unless and until a notification is given by an agent under subsection (3) sufficient moneys for the payment of charges, licenses, fees, rent or cess specified in his appointment notice shall be presumed to be held by him and this money shall be due to the County

(5) For the purposes of this section, the Executive Committee Member may, by notice in writing, at any time require any person to furnish him within a reasonable time, not being less than seven days from the date of service of the notice, with information showing any moneys which may be held by the agent for, or due by him to the County

(6) Where an agent fails to pay an amount of money collected under this section within the time specified in the notice commits an offence.

(7) An agent who has made a payment to the County under this section shall for all purposes be deemed to have acted therein with the authority of the County and shall be indemnified in respect of that payment against all proceedings, civil or criminal, and all process, judicial or extrajudicial, notwithstanding any provisions to the contrary in any written law, contract or agreement.

(8) Any person who wilfully makes any false or misleading statement, or wilfully conceals any material fact shall be guilty of an offence.

PART IV—OFFENCES AND PENALTIES

12. (1) Any person who commits an offence under this Act for which no penalty is provided shall be liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding two hundred thousand shillings or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year or both.

General Penalty.

(2) To maximise revenue collection, use of other arms of the National Government shall be applied during enforcement.

(3) The county revenue agent may impound items from non-compliant business entities.

(4) Any impounded item not claimed shall be auctioned after three months from the date of impoundment unless otherwise specified.

13. A member of staff of the County or any other person having duty to perform under this Act who—

Offences by Staff
of the County.

- (a) makes, in any record, or document required to be kept or made by that person, an entry which he or she knows or has reasonable cause to believe not to be true or to be false; or
- (b) wilfully refuses to do anything which he or she knows or has reasonable cause to know is required to be done; or
- (c) interferes with any other person or process under this Act, so as to defeat the provisions or requirements of this Act; or
- (d) where required under this Act to do anything to give effect to the provisions of this Act, fails to do

that thing; or

- (e) without reasonable cause omits to do something in breach of his or her duty under this Act; or
- (f) wilfully contravenes the provision of this Bill to give undue advantage or favour to another person; or
- (g) fails to prevent or report to the County or any other relevant authority, the commission of an offence committed under this Act;

Commits an offence and is liable on conviction, to a fine not exceeding two hundred thousand shillings or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year, or both

PART V — ILLEGAL BUSINESSES AND ACTIVITIES

14. (1) Gambling by use of Gaming machines/slots is illegal unless otherwise specified.

(2) All business premises shall have a waste disposal management system.

(3) It is an offence for travellers and passengers to board or/and alight from Public Service Vehicles at undesignated areas.

(4) It is an offence to conduct a business in a public space or road reserve without a request letter of the same from a client to the county government and an acceptance letter from the county government.

(5) It is an offence to graze cattle, goats, sheep, pigs, donkeys, or any other animal within the Central Business District. If any of the above animals is impounded by the County Government for more than 72 hrs, then they will be auctioned off.

(6) It is an offence for motorbikes to speed beyond 30km/hr. in towns, shopping centres, residential areas and markets.

(7) It is an offence for Motor Vehicle to speed beyond 50km/h in towns, shopping centres, residential areas and markets.

PART VI—MISCELLANEOUS

15. (1) Any fee, charge, license, rent or cess payable to the County at the commencement of this Act which is not included in any part of the Schedule to this Bill, shall continue to be chargeable and payable to the County unless specifically stopped by the law or until a County law relating to that fee, charge, license, rent or cess is enacted. Savings.

(2) All directions, resolutions, orders and authorizations on, or relating to financial management, including the collection and administration of fees and charges given or issued by the previous Municipal Councils, County Councils and Town Councils before the commencement of this Act shall be deemed to have been given, issued or made by or under the authority of the County Assembly until the expiry or repeal of those directions, resolutions, orders and authorizations, and shall continue, with the necessary modifications, to apply, be paid and administered under this Act.

16. The rate for fees, charges, licenses, cess or rent, applicable before the commencement of this Act, for businesses, activities, goods or services specified in the schedules, shall cease to apply at the commencement of this Act. Cessation.

MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

The object of this Bill is to impose or vary various fees, cess and other charges for various services provided by the County-

PART I of the Bill provides for preliminary provisions.

PART II of the Bill provides for the Charges, Licenses, Plot or House rent, Cess or Market fee to be paid to the county for services. It also provides for Amendments to the Act.

PART III of this Bill provides for the Appointment and duties of an agent in respect to collection of revenue for the county. It also provides for the mode of payment of revenue to the county.

PART IV of this Bill provides for the general penalty for offences committed under the Bill. It provides for offences carried out by staff of county and the penalty of the offenses.

PART of this Bill provides of miscellaneous, savings and cessation of rate of fees, charges, licenses, cess or rent applicable before the commencement of this Bill.
