THE UASIN GISHU COUNTY FINANCE ACT, 2013

No. 6 of 2013



Date of Assent: 20th November, 2013

Date of Commencement: By Notice

AN ACT of the Uasin Gishu County Assembly to provide for the various taxes, fees and charges for county services, and for other revenue raising measures by the County Government; and for the matters connected or incidental thereto.

ENACTED by the County Assembly of Uasin Gishu County as follows-

PART I- PRELIMINARY

1. This Act may be cited as the Finance Act, 2013 and shall come into operation on such a date as the County Executive Committee Member for Finance, with the concurrence of the Governor, may appoint and the different dates may be appointed for different provisions.

PART II-TAXES, FEES AND CHARGES PAYABLE AND RATES APPLICABLE

2. (1) The taxes, fees and charges set out in the "New Charges" column of the schedule shall apply for the respective items listed in the "Items Description" column and at the rates set out therein.

(2) For greater certainty, the taxes, fees and charges applicable are payable to the County of Uasin Gishu at the commencement of this Act, but which are not included in the schedule to this Act, shall continue to apply under the existing by-laws of the defunct Eldoret Municipal Council, County Council of Wareng, and Town Council of Burnt Forest, until such by-laws are specifically repealed or replaced by county legislation.

3. (1) All directions, resolutions, orders and authorizations on or relating to financial management, including the collection and administration of taxes, fees and charges given or issued by the defunct Municipal council and subsisting or valid immediately before the cessation of the application of the Local Government Act (now repealed) shall be deemed to have been given, issued

or made by or under the authority of the County Assembly until expiry, amendments or repeal of those directions, resolutions, orders and authorization on financial management and shall continue, with the necessary modifications, apply both to the payment and administration of the taxes, fees, charges and other levies under this Act.

(2) Subsection (1) does not apply to the specific respective amounts payable in respect of the taxes, fees, charges or other levies and, in that regard, the amount provided shall be as applicable shall be as provided for in the "New Charges" column in the Schedule.

County Assembly Standing Orders, in particular, standing Order No. 218 which requires the County Finance Bill to be presented to the County assembly as a legislative proposal to be acted upon by the assembly.

The Bill seeks to provide for the various taxes, fees, levies and other service charges that are payable to the Uasin Gishu County Government. These are set out in the schedules to the bill.

The first schedule is in respect of the departmental fees and charges whereas the second schedule is in respect of single Business permits with application fee. The said schedules also sets out the rates in Kenya Shillings (Kshs)) currently payable to the County Government so that it is possible to assess the changes that take into account the need to enhance the payable revenue for better service delivery and to enable the County Government perform the increased functions bestowed on it by the fourth Schedule of the Constitution of Kenya.

Statement on delegated powers to legislate the Executive Committee member responsible for Finance and economic Planning empowered to bring into operation the various provisions of the Act and the Schedules or certain sections thereof. This is to enable the putting in place of necessary physical, administrative and personnel, infrastructure that would and in the operationalisation of the collection of the proposed taxes, fees and charges.

The operationalisation of certain provisions of the proposed law shall entail on expenditure of Public Funds will be provided for in the estimates.
